He as previously served as the Minister of Law and Justice, having been shifted from the Ministry of Railways in the cabinet reshuffle of 5 July 2016. At the end of the previous Lok Sabha, he was the Minister of Statistics and Planning.

He is known for his Padyatras where he covers long distances on foot for a noble cause connecting villages and spreading awareness. His contribution to serving the nation can also be seen in his active participation in Pradhan Mantri Bharatiya Jan Aushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP).

He is well known for his intellect and thoughtful leadership, which he often exhibits in his speeches. In 2015, he was selected to represent India at the United Nations where he spoke about '2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development'. To implement simplicity in his professional life, he cycles to the Parliament during sessions.
